Pathways to Success

A-level qualifications – this is the traditional route into university. To gain access to this pathway you will need a B grade average at GCSE and B grades (grade 7 or above) in both English and Maths.

L3 Applied Qualifications – these qualifications are the equivalent to A levels and will provide a route through to university or onto an apprenticeship. One in four people at university have gained their place through an applied qualification. The entrance requirements for this pathway are 5 A-C qualifications at GCSE.
