RE: Barnhill Community Primary to Secondary Transition

We are delighted to hear that you have accepted your child's place to join us at Barnhill Community High School and we are very much looking forward to welcoming your family to the Middlesex Learning Partnership. Due to the current situation regarding Covid-19, we will be operating a blended transition process during the summer term. This means that we may have already visited your child in their primary school, or are planning to and that you will have the opportunity to visit the school on Tuesday 6th July (details of this will be emailed to you and updated on the school website). More than ever before, we understand that the transition process from primary to secondary education can be a daunting experience. We want to reassure you that we will assist you in any way we can to ensure all students arrive, whenever their first day at Barnhill may be, excited and fully informed about the next exciting chapter of their education.

To support us in planning a smooth transition we would like you to complete an on-line form by **Friday 18th of June.** Please <u>CLICK HERE</u> to complete the form and remember to press submit at the end. The on-line form will help us to plan for the new academic year and prepare students as best we can. If you are unable to complete the form online or would like some support, our dedicated staff will be more than happy to assist you in completing the form.

When completing the form, please could you send a copy of the following documents below:

- Child's birth certificate/passport
- Parent/Carer proof of address (please note: we do not accept bank statements)
- Home school agreement (this is attached in the email) this will be to be signed by the parent and student.

Please send this to <u>cfranklin@barnhill.school</u> this will be filed for your child to make sure we have the correct documents ready to start school.

If you require **Free School Meals**, please follow the link to check if you are eligible. <u>https://pps.lgfl.org.uk/</u> you will need your national insurance number for this. At the end of the check (if you are eligible) you will be presented with a certificate on the screen. Please screen-shot this certificate and send to this email <u>fsm@barnhill.school</u> please provide the child's full name/DOB in the email.

At Barnhill our ethos is 'together, achieving our best' and we understand that, at some point during school, all students require some additional support. To help us help you, please could you has had help in the form of SEND or school counselling when filling in the form. Although we receive detailed information from our feeder schools about every student, we would like to offer parents/carers the opportunity to share any SEND/SEMH information to help us organise the best possible support. Once received, Mrs Mohamed and Mrs Gibbons (SENDCo and Deputy SENDCo) will be making contact with parents/carers shortly after half term offering information tailored to your personal situation. There may be some opportunity for socially distanced face-to-face contact meetings to take place post lockdown for identified children and their families if considered essential.
