

## 16-19 TUITION FUND DEPLOYMENT, 2021-22

This additional funding is provided by central government to support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English, Mathematics and other courses where learning has been disrupted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

The 16-19 Tuition Fund will be deployed to assist the following priority groups of students with small group tuition:

1. Students who have not yet achieved a Grade 4 in English and/or Mathematics.
2. Any students with a grade 4 in English and Mathematics who also need catch up support.
3. Students with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND).
4. Disadvantaged students
5. Students whose subjects and progress has been most adversely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic specifically those with low prior attainment in the academic year 2021 to 2022.


At Barnhill Sixth Form the tuition and additional support will be delivered using a blend of online and in-school delivery. Tuition sessions will be scheduled in addition to the planned programme of study, but will also be used to help students on to successful destinations and to support them throughout and following the COVID-19 pandemic.

Examples of some of the additional support we will offer include:

- GCSE Maths & English resit preparation
- Teaching Assistant support and mentoring
- Appointments with the Independent Careers Adviser
- Personal statement support
- Subject specific catch-up
- Academic mentoring
- Study skills sessions from a third party provider.

The impact of these sessions will be monitored based on student performance, progress in their courses and their preparation for and confidence in applying to future destinations, including higher education, employment and apprenticeships.
